Fifth Grade Reader

This is the age when academic strengths and weaknesses are fairly evident to students and teachers alike. For example, if your child has a "knack" for math, she may have been placed in an advanced class already, and the work may come relatively easy to her. On the other hand, she might dread history because she finds it boring and can not keep the time periods straight. Ten year olds have a wide range of abilities, but a desire and willingness to learn can make all the difference, especially in

subject areas that may present more of a challenge.

- Explain the differences between genres —
 biographies, poetry, mysteries, plays, historical fiction and read books in each category
- Know how to use the library (computer catalogues, periodicals, the Dewey Decimal system)
- Read more complex texts (textbooks and

fiction) to build vocabulary and comprehension skills
