Crayon Candle Instructions

1. Plan out the color layers you want your candle to have and unwrap the crayons you'll need. Fill a paper cup halfway with soy wax shavings.

Microwave for 30 seconds, stir with a popsicle stick, and repeat until the wax is melted.



2. Pour a thin layer of the wax at the bottom of your candle jar. Place your wick in the middle and hold it in place with two popsicle sticks. Let it dry completely (5–10 minutes) before moving on to the next step.



3. Fill a paper cup 3/4 of the way with soy wax shavings and place a broken crayon on top. Microwave for 30 seconds, stir with a popsicle stick, and repeat until the wax and crayon have completely melted.

4. As you work, you can add more wax shavings to the melted wax in your cup to give you more to work with (especially if you're filling all 3 candles at once!).



5. Move the popsicle sticks out of your way, carefully pour the wax into your jar, then put the popsicle sticks back to hold the wick in place. Try not to let wax drip down the side as you pour! If it does, let it dry and then scrape it away with a popsicle stick.



6. Let this layer dry completely (20–30 minutes) before moving onto the next one. Repeat until All of your layers are complete. Trim your wick and your candle is ready!
