V. OLD BUSINESS

A. LANDSCAPING

- Quotation/Proposal The Board discussed the "Quotation/Proposal for Benbrook Library May 23, 2002" from Grasseaters Incorporated, a company located in Benbrook.
- Other Options Sherwin will continue to investigate options through other landscaping companies and present them to the Board for evaluation and comparison.
- 3. Fundraising Jean and Joe Sherwin have definite plans to stage a "karaoke" event at the Benbrook Summerfest on June 29, with proceeds going toward landscaping for the Library. At least seven volunteers will be needed to help.

B. OTHER OLD BUSINESS

Olmstead suggested looking into selling personalized bricks for a wall or walkway (similar to those sold by the Fort Worth

Public Library) to raise funds for the building program. The Building Committee will be asked to investigate this possibility.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. TEXAS PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS

Baldwin presented for the Board's information the handbook of the Texas Workforce Commission titled Especially for Texas Employers. He will examine its contents to look for areas that may be lacking in the Library's policies for employees and will work with the District's attorney to verify compliance with workforce policies in Texas.

B. FY 2002-2003 BUDGET

Baldwin will present a "draft" of the budget at the Board's July meeting, with the intent that it will be revised as needed and presented for the Board's approval at the August regular meeting. The budget will be written with the expectation of no increase in sales tax revenue, and with the absence of the Establishment Grant, which has provided an additional \$30,000 each year for the past three years. Operating costs are likely to increase, especially in the area of employee health insurance. The Director anticipates reducing the amount budgeted toward purchase of new books since the Library's core collection has been brought up to standards and is supplemented with online and Metropac resources. He will continue to seek grants and gifts and will also investigate fundraising possibilities to enhance revenue.

The Board will next meet on July 01, 2002.

D. OTHER NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Proposed Calendar The Director presented the Proposed Calendar of Events for Benbrook Library District for Fiscal Year 2002 2003.
- 2. Loan Statistics The Director presented the Monthly Inter/Intra Library Loan Statistics Report for May 2002 which showed the number of books loaned to and borrowed from the Benbrook Public Library by libraries within the MetroPac system.

3. Volunteer Appreciation - An "After-Dinner Social" will be held at 7:00 p. m. on July 15, 2002 at the Library to recognize and show support for our dedicated volunteers.
