



# Recycle Beyond the Bag

The Benbrook Public Library is a permanent donation site for collecting plastic bags. Patrons are welcome to drop off items at any time during our business hours. The bins are located between the two glass doors at the back entrance of the library.

Benbrook library staff directly distribute donated items to the appropriate locations. Please be mindful when dropping off items. A list of acceptable and non-acceptable items can be seen below and on the donation bins.

*Plastic must be clean, dry, and free of food and organic residue.*

## ITEMS WE CAN ACCEPT

- Grocery Bags
- Produce Bags
- Ice Bags
- Ziploc Bag
- Plastic wrap
- Cereal Box Liners
- Newspaper sleeves
- Dry cleaning Bags
- Bubble wrap
- Plastic shipping envelopes
- Pallet wrap and stretch film

## ITEMS WE CANNOT ACCEPT

- Pet food bags
- Meat packaging
- Chip Bags
- Floral wrap

## **STILL UNSURE?**

-See if the package will stretch when you pull it. If yes, it can be included. If it tears like paper, then please don't put it in the bin.

-Is the package shiny, or does it make a crinkly/crunchy sound in your hand?  
If yes, do NOT recycle in the bin
